Deuteronomy 7:9 (ESV)

Know therefore that the Lord your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations,

I. Our Personal Covenant

Genesis 15:5-6,18 (NIV)

He said, "Look up at the heavens and count the stars — if indeed you can count them." Then he said, "So shall your offspring be." Abram believed the LORD, and he credited it to him as righteousness. On that day the LORD made a covenant with Abram

Genesis 17:7 (NIV)

And I will establish my covenant between me and you and your descendants after you throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and to your descendants after you.

Hebrews 9:15 (NIV)

Hebrews 9:15

- A Call to Freedom

Romans 6:6,14 (NIV)

For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin— because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace.

- A Call to Fellowship

I Corinthians 1:9 (ESV)

God is faithful, by whom you were called into the fellowship of his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.
